# **BIBLIOGRAPHICAL FORM SHEET**

Your bibliography must list **every** source you use in researching your topic, even those you used little of. Sources must be listed alphabetically, by authors' last names.

#### Books

**one author:** Last name, First name. *Title.* City: Publisher, year.

*ex-* Young, Terry D. *Teaching 8th Grade.* Boston: Houghton-Mifflin Co., 1896.

**two authors:** Last name, First name and Last name, First name. *Title.* City: Publisher, year.

*ex*- Young, Terry D. and Old, Jerry G. *Life Upstairs*. San Francisco: Crown Press, 1999.

**no author:** *Title.* City: Publisher, year.

*ex- Skateboards I Have Known.* Chicago: Nonpareil Press, 1985.

# Magazines

**author given:** Last name, First name. "Title of Article." *Name of Magazine*, Date of magazine, pages of article.

*ex*- Young, David B. "How to Be a Kid." *Good Housekeeping*. June 1995, pp. 12-14.

**no author:** "Title of Article." *Name of Magazine*, Date of magazine, pages of article.

ex- "Golden Gate Bridge at 50." *Time*, December 14, 1986, p. 62.

### Encyclopedias

signed article: Last name, First name. "Title of Article," *Name of Encyclopedia*, Year of publication, pages of article.

*ex*- Silvestri, Cathy. "Paperwork," *Encyclopedia Britannica*, 1980, pp. 1234-56.

**unsigned article:** "Title of Article," *Name of Encyclopedia*, Year of publication,

pages of article.

ex- "Basketball," *Encyclopedia of Sports,* 1952, pp. 324-27.

# <u>Newspapers</u>

**author given:** Last name, First name. "Title of Article," *Name of Newspaper,* Date of newspaper, pages of article.

*ex*- Riddle, Wayne. "Dancing til Dawn," *San Francisco Chronicle*, August 30, 1993, pp. 8-9.

**no author:** "Title of Article," *Name of* 

Newspaper, Date of newspaper, pages of article.

ex- "Fun with Eggplants," New York Times, January 15, 1886, p. 12.

### When referring to an on-line encyclopedia:

Last name, First name. "Title of Article." Name of encyclopedia, On-line Edition, Downloaded from [Name of Network], date of downloading.

*ex*- Smith, John. "Robert E. Lee." Compton's Encyclopedia, On-line Edition, Downloaded from America Online, January 31, 1997.

## When referring to information from the Internet/www:

Signed websites: Last Name, First Name. "Page Title." Website Title. Web Address (retrieved Date Accessed).

Ex-- Smith, John. "Obama Inaugurated as President." CNN.com.

Unsigned websites: If no author is available, begin the citation with the website owner, if known.
