## **Term Paper Checklist**

- <u>Cover/Binding</u>: paper must be bound along left-hand edge. A cover with clasps will accomplish this.
- \_\_\_\_\_Margins: Left margin is to be 1.5 inches. Top, bottom and right margins should be 1 inch.
- \_\_\_\_\_Spacing: Please double-space. Do not use 1.5 spaces.
- \_\_\_\_\_Title Page: date should be the assigned due date, regardless of when you submit your paper. *Remember to change the date of your final draft!*
- Table of Contents: Should list *start page only* for each chapter, as well as for bibliography and endnotes (if you have any). Page numbers should be listed in a straight column, toward right-hand side of page. *If your paper has been revised, check to see if final draft's page numbers are the same as first draft.*
- \_\_\_\_\_Introduction: Contains a brief overview of what you intend to accomplish in your paper. Includes your thesis, <u>underlined</u>, stated clearly.
- **\_\_\_\_Conclusion**: Restates your thesis, <u>underlined</u>, and provides references to the key points made in your paper that support your thesis.
- \_\_\_\_\_Dates/Numbers: Dates are written *June 3, 2002*, <u>NOT</u> *June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2002*. All numbers below eleven should be spelled out. Use *five*, not *5*, unless you're writing a date.
- \_\_\_\_\_Titles: All titles should be capitalized. This includes table of contents, bibliography and each chapter. Never end a page with title of next chapter.
- \_\_\_\_\_Sources: Three books, two periodicals and one on-line source are required, and must be listed in bibliography.
- **\_\_\_\_Bibliography**: One list containing all sources, listed alphabetically. DO NOT separate by type of source. Include all sources used. Be sure to list all 6 required sources. Second line of each entry must be indented.
- Footnotes/Endnotes: You are required to use both ibid. and op. cit. in your footnotes. (Do not write "Smythe" in your op. cit!)
- Footnote/Endnote Form: Footnotes appear at the end of the sentence, after all punctuation.
- \_\_\_\_\_Page numbers: Every page following the table of contents must be numbered.
- Proof Read: Proof read, proof read, proof read!!! You will lose big points for wasting my time fixing elementary grade errors.
